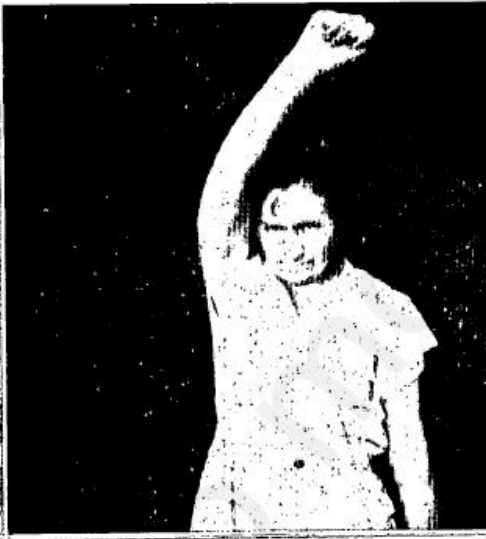

THOUSANDS SEE HEALER LAY HANDS ON FAITHFUL

In a tense atmosphere a young man holds in one hand a steel leg brace which had supported his lame limb for over a year.

"My leg is healed," he gasps. "I can walk normally again."

"Glory Halleluja," exclaims a large congregation in amazement. "A-men . . . A-men . . . A-men."

The scene is a big tent at the corner of Quadra and Pembroke Streets where for two weeks hundreds of sick and ailing people have passed through in the hope of finding some relief for their afflictions . . . hopeless cases of medical science.

More than 2,000 persons are seated in the massive tent where Evangelist A. C. Valdez, Jr., of Arizona, is conducting a faith healing service. The congregation is composed mostly of Victorians, but some have come from distant parts of British Columbia and the United States to see the "miracles."

The young evangelist, a thick set, dark-haired man, wearing a light-grey suit, a white shirt and bow tie, stands on a raised platform. There is nothing striking about his outward appearance. His speech, however, is dynamic, forceful and sometimes deeply emotional.

WAIT FOR MIRACLE

Waiting in an aisle is a long line of suffering humanity, young and old, some with faces distorted with pain. Nearby are stretcher cases, cripples in wheel chairs, old people who need some support to stand. They are all waiting . . . waiting for a miracle to happen.

The moment has arrived. All is tense. The faith healer walks to a wheel chair where a thin, pale young man sits. He is paralyzed from the waist down.

"Affliction I curse thee," says the evangelist. "Stand up now, you are getting better."

The man stands. Spectators gasp. Tears roll down the face of a well-dressed grey-haired business man kneeling in prayer.

The preacher moves to another patient. This time to a young Chinese girl on a stretcher. He touches her. The girl cries out: "Thank you God, thank you God." Her small voice penetrates to the far corners of the tent.

That is what this reporter saw in the big tent.

There were many testimonies of cures.

Jean Parker, 545 Hillside Avenue, claimed sight was restored to her left eye.

C. J. Rodway, 38, 1848 Hollywood Crescent, reported his left leg, injured two years ago in an accident, had healed. Physicians had expressed the fear that he would never again have full use of his limb because the main ligament and muscles were damaged, he said.

W. C. Astrope, 921 Darwin, testified that he could hear with his left ear, damaged by an exploding shell in First World War. Doctors

RAYMOND T. RICHEY OLD TIME REVIVAL AND HEALING MEETINGS

Brother Richey has taken a leave of absence from his church, The Evangelistic Temple, Houston, Texas, and has re-entered the evangelistic field. Good reports are coming in of souls being saved and bodies being healed in the Raymond T. Richey revivals.

For many years, Brother Richey conducted big revivals all over the country. During World War II, he used the big red, white and blue tent in work among the Servicemen.

WHAT TO DO WHEN DEATH STRIKES

In relating this experience, which came to me recently, I do so, trusting that it will give help and encouragement to others who may have a desperate encounter with the enemy. For a quarter of a century, I have enjoyed almost uninterrupted health, and on several occasions when sickness has attempted to secure a foothold in our home, God miraculously intervened and delivered us from all the works of Satan. I say this not boastfully, but as one who is humbly grateful for God's grace and mercy, which He has always seen fit to extend to us.

A few weeks ago, I was engaged in some important business in the East. It required my being up 'till very late hours, and on some nights, I secured very little sleep. This was nothing new to me, since ordinarily, two o'clock in the morning has been the time I usually retire.

THE DEVIL STRIKES UNAWARES

About a day or two after I began this business trip, I became aware that a boil of some kind was forming on the back of my neck. Boils are usually inconsequential incidents, and I hardly gave the matter a passing thought. The next day, however, I noticed that the swelling was not the same as that of an ordinary boil. Had I been at home, I certainly would have followed my usual pattern of action when any kind of sickness has seemed to threaten. I mean by this that at such times I always wait upon God until I feel that I have dominion over what may seem to be portending trouble. But I was at the busiest part of my journey and matters I was dealing with were of such nature they were occupying all my attention and time. My mistake was a common one—people usually do not get in earnest when an affliction threatens, until the thing becomes securely entrenched.

Concluding my business on Friday, I found myself at the great Washington, D. C., airport, a little after midnight, standing by for possible space on an airliner headed west. It was at this time that I realized something was seriously wrong. The boil now extended over a space of several inches in width and was quite painful.

I was fortunate to get a plane that took me as far as Memphis. But arriving at the city, I was too weak to proceed further, and so remained overnight in a hotel. By morning, I found that the infection had spread across my entire neck, and was extremely hard and painful when touched.

I LEARN THE SERIOUSNESS OF MY CONDITION

While waiting for a plane, I determined to find out just what the trouble was, and made an inquiry of a local physician. He took just a brief glance and his face paled. Looking at me earnestly, he said, "Sir, I am sorry to tell you this, but this is a most serious infection—it is a carbuncle, and has developed to the point where it is going to give you great trouble; such things often result in . . ." his voice trailed off, and then continued, "the infection is near your spinal cord, and can result in spinal meningitis." He spoke decisively, "You must have medical treatment at once."

I was weak and exhausted and in no condition to argue. So I said, "Doctor, I thank you for this information, but I will do nothing until I reach Shreveport. My plane leaves shortly." The physician was a kindly man, and he was convinced I did not realize the gravity of the situation. He admonished, he urged, he cajoled, he begged, he almost threatened. But I was adamant. If this was a matter of life and death, then I must throw myself on the mercy of Jehovah Rapha, the Lord our Healer; and weak as I was, I did not feel that I

could convince him. He looked at me again and, almost with tears in his eyes, said, "If you do not have the money, don't worry over that. Your life is more important than money." Of course, the money was not the object, and I could not but appreciate the kindly solicitude of the physician.

When the doctor saw that I would not undergo medical treatment in Memphis, he turned to me and said, "I'll let you go on one condition—that you will call your physician as soon as you reach Shreveport." I replied, "Doctor, I promise you that the moment I get to Shreveport I'll call on my Physician." I kept that promise, even before I got to Shreveport. I most earnestly called on my Physician—the Great Physician, the Sympathizing Jesus.

THE BATTLE BEGINS

In Shreveport, the battle began. I believe that an answer from heaven came the first day, but due to an organized attack of the powers of hell, the result was not manifest immediately. Because of the peculiar part TVH plays in these great salvation-healing revivals, the devil evidently believed he could effect a damaging blow, if he could get its editor out of the way. No man is indispensable, yet each of us is given a task that is peculiarly our own.

Having great confidence in the prayers of others, I sent out telegrams to several of my brethren containing the following words: "The devil has struck me with a serious infection. I am convinced as with Daniel, the answer has already been sent. Undoubtedly this attack is tied up with the devil's attempt to frustrate the rapidly growing work of TVH. Please hold on to God with me for the manifestation of complete deliverance."

At this point, I wish to express my deep

appreciation for all those who held faith with me, and some who visited and prayed with me. We are members of one Body, and the prayers and faith of others are of great significance and importance.

I asked my wife to bring me a medical dictionary from the office. I wanted to find out just how bad a carbuncle was. Although she has a good memory, each day she "forgot" to bring it. Later, when I was back at the office, I read what it had to say. It was as follows: CARBUNCLE: A name applied to a very painful—and dangerous affection—the skin gives way at several places, and through these openings, the core of the carbuncle is seen as a grayish-white slough—it is accompanied by severe general disturbance, due to the absorption of poisons produced by the microbes in the carbuncle—the process causes great exhaustion to the patient, and from this exhaustion, or more actual poisoning, death often follows. It is customary—to open the carbuncle with a cross-shaped incision— After I read this doleful obituary, I had a suspicion that my wife "forgot" to bring the book on purpose.

THE BATTLE RAGES

For three days the battle raged. I could feel the terrific impact of spiritual forces in action, in which the carbuncle seemed to be the nerve center of the battle arena. In the natural, the issue seemed in doubt. But in the spiritual realm, God gave me peace, and I could feel that the Spirit of God was raising up a standard against this menacing power that was searching for my life. The struggle went on for hours—sometimes in the middle of the night. After I had prayed for healing, I ceased begging or crying. I have often seen this method used and it is worse than useless. I just kept praising God for the victory that I knew was surely mine.

One other thing I did. I searched my life carefully, and asked the Spirit of God to turn the searchlight on anything that was displeasing to Him. An attack by the enemy should always be a means of drawing us closer to God. A great mistake, and one alas made too often, is that when Satan strikes, people begin to whine and say, "I don't know why this had to come on me." An attack by the enemy, may not indicate any outbroken sin, but it often indicates that we have let the devil break down the hedge of Divine protection somewhere, if only that we have failed to obey the laws of rest, diet, health, etc.

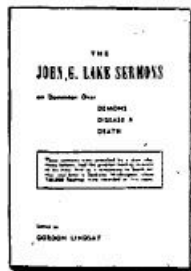

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THE STORY OF THE HEALING REVIVAL AT THE FULL GOSPEL TABERNACLE IN KANSAS CITY

(In case of a National Emergency, great mass meetings might be curbed, as in World War II. It is extremely important that the healing revival will get its roots down within the local church. To encourage this, TVH is featuring articles each month describing remarkable healing revivals occurring in local churches.)

About four years ago word came to us that a man by the name of William Branham was ministering in different places with real Apostolic power. The gifts being manifest through him were phenomenal—not having been witnessed in our generation. We began immediately to try and get Brother Branham to come to Kansas City, Kansas. In April, 1948, he came for five short days. What we witnessed (together with those who gathered from almost every state in the Union) we shall never forget. Diseases were detached and expelled by the power of the Name of Jesus. Miracles had become normal rather than the rarity as before.

For many years I have prayed for the sick in my ministry and have seen some unusual deliverances, but never was my heart so stirred as when I saw what God could do and was beginning to do in this day. I got alone with God and prayed: "Dear Lord, it looks to me that you are doing a new thing in the earth. This looks like a revival for these last days. I don't know if you can use me or not. But if you don't want me, you will have to push me out of the path; because I am placing myself, as best I know, at your disposal." I have thanked Him more than once that He did not entirely put me aside, but has given me and my church some part in this revival.

Two burdens were placed upon my heart as I prayed. First, to see the full-orbed operations of the sign-gift ministry in the local church. Though we are in full accord with union meetings and have promoted them here, we felt the ultimate in God's plan is to have the gifts in operation in all local churches. I mentioned this to some, including Brother Branham, and was assured I was on the right track. The second burden placed on my heart was to have a ministry in a radius of my church—in smaller communities where union meetings would never reach. As I read the Word of God, this burden was confirmed there.

I began to preach faith to my local church and to tell them what I had felt the will of God to be for us. It began to "take" and it was not long until things began to happen. One Wednesday night, in our mid-week service, the presence of the Spirit was very mighty. Soon a deacon arose and gave a rather strange utterance—no doubt a prophetic utterance. He said, "People, we are about to get lost in God. Something is about to happen." Then it seemed that the Power of God moved into that room as it did in the upper room at Pentecost. The visitation was so real that The Full Gospel Tabernacle

has never been the same since. The people began to come forward for prayer. The first was a little lady, Mrs. Charles Owsley, who was suffering from pernicious anemia, double curvature of the spine, and spots on her lungs, which the doctors feared was tuberculosis. As I laid hands on her, I felt as though I had hold of an electric charger. When the "charge" ceased, I knew she was healed. Medical examination less than a week later gave her a clean slate. She was well! Later, this same woman contracted cancer of the throat and tongue. She had an ugly mass on her tongue and a large lump in her throat that laboratory tests proved positive. In one week from the offering of prayer, she was pronounced cured. The doctors could not even find the place where they had removed tissue from the throat for tests.

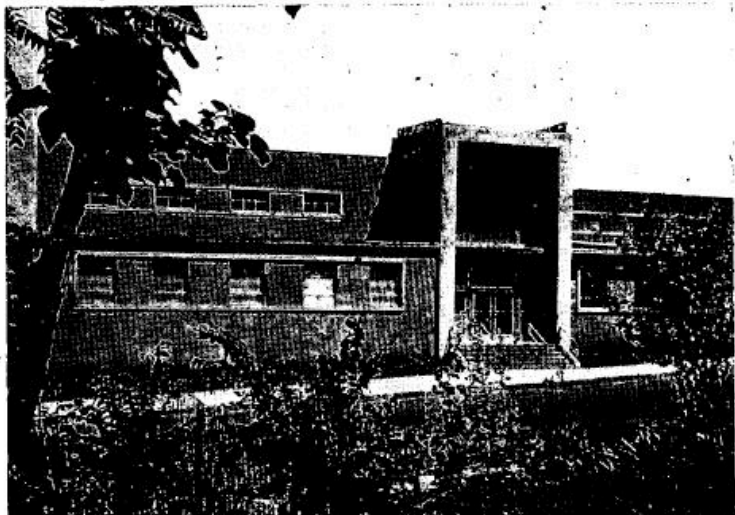
We could multiply this testimony by many times if space permitted. We have positive testimony of healings in our local church covering the field of cancer, arthritis, sugar diabetes, skin ulcers (open sores for fifteen (15) years), gall bladder infection, heart disorder, etc. I can say of a truth, that when prayer is offered for the sick in the church today, the people expect to see results. We used to pray and hope the law of averages would give us some who would be healed. We no longer pray, invoking the law of averages. We pray, invoking the law of faith, which is a perfect law working every time. Our people are no longer surprised if some one is healed. They are honestly surprised if the person prayed for is not healed. Prayer

is made for the sick in all our services and people come for healing because that fact is known. Just two nights ago two ladies came from out of the city for prayer. One of them had an extreme nervous disorder and had not been able to sleep. She called in yesterday and said she had a wonderful sleep the night before.

The results of this revival in the local church could be nothing but good. Since this visitation in the church of the ministry of deliverance, we have added about one hundred and fifty members to our rolls (though this is not our prime objective. Our aim is to be a blessing to all people who need us); we have constructed a new edifice hoping it would take care of local healing meetings. We are afraid this building will prove too small. Balconies can, and will, be added later. The ultimate seating capacity will be about twelve to fourteen hundred.

Rev. Branham came back last fall in one of the greatest meetings we had seen to that time. This spring we were privileged to have Clifton Erickson in our church for a month. We saw one hundred saved, about fifty filled with the Spirit, and miracles of healing every night. Others, including Jack Coe, have ministered in our city. We thank God for what has been done, not only in our church, but in the churches in this entire area. Some have been revived that were struggling for existence. The end is not yet. This ministry should be in every church. I believe it will be, ere Jesus comes.

Questions and Answers

QUESTION:

Because of the great numbers of miracles and healings that are taking place, I think that the majority of people believe that God heals today. However, while some teach that God heals on the basis of His sovereignty, they deny that Divine healing is through Christ's Atonement. What is your view of this teaching? (This question has appeared in a number of letters coming to our office.)

ANSWER:

TVH takes a most serious view of such teaching, for it is fundamentally false, and is indeed a dangerous error. When Modernism first crept into the church, its advocates professed to believe in salvation, but declared it was not necessary to believe that it came through the Atonement. It is unnecessary to be reminded of the appalling disaster and apostasy that has come to the churches which temporized with, and permitted this teaching to gain ascendancy in their midst.

Now some would arise and declare that they believe in healing, but that there is no need to believe that it comes through Christ's Atonement. May every Christian ever keep this thought in his mind—no man receives any blessing from God except that it has come through the Atonement!

If there is anything that the Scriptures make clear, it is that Divine healing is in the Atonement. Isa. 53:4 declares, "Surely He hath borne our griefs (kholee-sicknesses) and carried our sorrows (makob-pains). Notice that the word "griefs" is translated from "kholee." It is the same word used in Deut. 7:15, where God says, "The Lord will take away from thee all sickness (kholee). Then Isa. 53:4 literally reads, "Surely He hath borne our sicknesses."

In Isa. 53:12, we read of Christ's vicarious Atonement for sin. "And He bore (nasa) the sin of many." How did Christ bear our sins? Vicariously as our substitute. Now notice the 4th verse again. "Surely He hath borne (nasa)

our sicknesses." Notice that the same Hebrew word "nasa" is used. Therefore as Christ bore (nasa) our sins, so He has borne (nasa) our sicknesses. Nothing could be clearer. This is not a private interpretation, but the conclusion of the great commentators. Take for example, Young's translation (p. 452) which reads: "Surely our sicknesses He hath borne, and our pains He hath carried them."

But Matthew's comment on Isa. 53:4 is final and utterly conclusive. That inspired writer interprets Isaiah's prophecy in the following words: "When even was come, they brought unto Him many that were possessed of devils; and He cast out the spirits with His Word, and healed all that were sick; that it might be fulfilled which was spoken by Esaias the prophet, saying, Himself took our infirmities and bore our sickness." Matt. 8:14-17.

Some, in an effort to oppose Divine healing, assert that the words that Matthew uses, "that it might be fulfilled," indicate that it was all fulfilled that evening in Capernaum when Jesus healed the sick, and the prophecy has no further fulfillment. Notice that the same words, "that it might be fulfilled," are used by Matthew in Matt. 12:17. In this prophecy, Christ was to show salvation to the Gentiles. Was that all fulfilled when Jesus was on earth? Any Sunday School child knows that Christ has been saving Gentiles all during this age, and will continue to do so until He comes in glory. Likewise healing of the sick, wherever there has been faith, has been continued by Christ through the church, all through this age, and even to this present day.

We do not have space to record the vast array of evidence concerning the fact that Divine healing is in the Atonement, but it is interesting to notice that Isa. 53:5 backs up the great truth of the 4th verse with the words, "And with His stripes we are healed." Paul tells us in Galatians 3:13, "Christ hath re-

deemed us from the curse of the law." Notice that the curse of the law included every kind of sickness. Deut. 28:15-47. Some people seem to think that under Grace we lose all the blessings of the law and keep all the curses. Just the opposite is true. Under Grace, we escape the curses and keep the blessings. Under the Law, God said that He would take sickness from our midst. (Exodus 23:25.) It would be strange indeed if we got less under Grace than under Law!

Again we repeat that every good thing comes to us through the Atonement of Christ and not through our merits. The only possible question that could arise, would be whether the time has yet come for us to enjoy Divine healing. Could it be for a future age? Would it be possible that like the promise of the resurrection, secured through the Atonement, the time of the enjoyment of Divine healing has not yet come?

Ten thousand reasons cry in chorus that now is the time when the promise is in effect! Foremost is the fact, that if the promise is ever fulfilled, it must be now. In Heaven, we won't need healing. There are no sick there. After the resurrection, we won't need healing, because sickness cannot touch us. Now is the only time that Divine healing will do us any good.

1. Furthermore: God has revealed Himself to us as Jehovah—Rapha—God our Healer. Exodus. 15:26.
2. The psalmist admonishes us not to forget all of God's benefits, one of which is, "Who healeth all thy diseases."
3. Christ always encouraged those who exercised faith for healing. (Luke 8:48.) He reproached those who didn't have faith. (Luke 4:27.)
4. He declared that one of the signs of true believers was that they should lay hands on the sick and they should recover. Mark 16:15-18.
5. The Gospel was not to change in anywise during the church age. Matt. 28:20.
6. Gifts of healing were to be given to the church. I Cor. 12:9.
7. The church was instructed and commanded to pray for the sick, and the Lord would raise them up. James 5:14-16.

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DEMON POSSESSION

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Oral Roberts

All my life I have been afraid of demons. My oldest sister was tormented by these strange powers. From the age of five until she was nineteen she had convulsions. When she was nineteen, God, in mercy, took her soul to a better world than this.


My father has been a minister all my life. He is a minister now, and he has always warned me against demons. He said, "Oral, when you come to cast out demons, unless you have the power of God over demons you're in great danger of being attacked yourself." Prior to my special call from God in May, 1947, I was called upon to cast out demon spirits only a few times. Each time I faced people possessed with demons, I had a great fear and trembling; I was fearful that they would attack me.

Therefore, I never had much success casting out demons. But when Jesus spoke to me in an audible voice and said, "From this hour you will heal the sick and cast out demons by My power," I believed His word unto me; the awful fear was lifted from me like you take a wet blanket off somebody. I was able to face the demons in those people possessed with them, with no fear whatever but with great faith in God and power in my life. I shall never forget the first experience I had shortly afterward. I had a long healing line facing me in Oklahoma. A woman came before me who was possessed with many demons. When I started to pray for her, the demons violently seized her body and threw her on the ground at my feet. Her head struck the floor and it seemed that it would pop open. She lay there writhing and kicking and gnawing her tongue, foaming at the mouth, her hands turned in toward her body. I did not know what to do; I had never seen anyone cast out demons and had no successful experience myself up till that time. I faced her, not knowing where to turn; suddenly the Spirit of God came upon me and I trembled with God's presence. I reached down, took her hand in my right hand and said, "Thou foul tormenting demons, I adjure thee in the name of Jesus Christ of Nazareth, come out of this woman! Loose her, and let her go free!" Instantly her body shook from head to toe; she raised up her head and looked at me. I did not know what was going to happen. I did not even know that she was healed because I had had no previous experience. When the Lord's power came upon me, I took His command over the demons. Suddenly she looked up at me. I saw her countenance change. I said, "In Jesus' Name, rise!" She sprang to her feet like some invisible force had lifted her, threw up her hands and began crying, "Jesus Christ has healed me and has made me free!" That was my first time to cast out demons through God's power and I won the victory in Jesus' Name over the first demons I faced!

RECOGNIZING DEMONS

Many times I know there are demon-possessed people in the healing line before they ever get to me, because I can feel them through God's power of discernment in me. When I lay my hand upon their head or I take their hand in my right hand, and the spirit of God comes in my hand, then I feel this sensation in my hand. Demons have power too. Their power is challenged by God's power in my hand. I discern them by name and number just like you take the pages of a book and count the pages as you turn them one by one. Pressure of the demons comes against God's power in my hand like that and I count the number of the demons by the strange pressure they make. I count them—one, two, three, four, five, six or seven and I know exactly how many demons are there

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and their names. God gives me their names so that I know what kind each demon is. As I pray, the strong pressure of the demons comes against me, like a strong man is pushing me back. Then as God's power comes in my hand against the demon-pressure, the demons give way. God's power increases until there is nothing left reacting against His presence in me. A great joy wells up within me and pretty soon I am shouting, "There they go! There they go!" And they are cast out by the power of Jesus Christ, the Son of God!

This is one of the signs that Jesus is coming soon, and that we are in the last days. The nearer we get to the end-time—preachers will tell you this—the nearer we get to the Lord's coming the more demons are going to work, and possess people and torment them; and the more God is going to give His servants power to cast them out. "For where sin doth abound, grace doth much more abound!"

THE POWER OF DEMONS

The power of demons is simply appalling. I never knew the frightful power of demons until God revealed Himself to me concerning my present ministry. Of course, I heard them whisper that my sister had demons. All my life I have heard Papa and Mama talk of how Velma was afflicted. I remember seeing Velma only a few times since I was a child when she died. But during the brief years I have been in this ministry, I have begun to realize the awesome power of demon spirits. I know the Bible teaches their power and I have seen that power with my own eyes. I have brought God's deliverance to thousands of the demon-possessed. Those who have unclean demons have what I call, "snake eyes." Their eyes look exactly like the eyes of a serpent. I am not talking about those have epileptic spirits or who have a deaf and dumb spirit or a spirit of fear. I am not talking about that. I refer only to the unclean demons referred to in the Bible. When they seize a person, he becomes exactly what the demon is;

the demons take complete control and look from their eyes and speak with their tongue and use their mind, soul and body. Demons have personalities. They are evil spirits. They are as much a personality as a human being is a personality. They can speak and their language is intelligible one to the other in their own special way, but they can speak as a human speaks, by using the tongue of a human being.

Paul and Silas came into town preaching a mighty revival with signs and wonders, and a young girl, who was possessed of many demons, saw them and began to follow them. Demons know God, they know Jesus and they know the servants of Jesus; the demons used her voice, saying, "Paul, Silas! Thou servants of the most High God, we know thee who thou art." Day after day she followed them and these demons screamed out their names and that they were the servants of the most High God. Paul's spirit was stirred within him and he turned one day and said to these demons, "I adjure thee by Jesus, come out of her and enter no more into her!" The demons came out of her; she was free; she could not tell fortunes any more and her owners who possessed her, body and soul, were mad and infuriated at Paul and Silas and had them thrown into jail.

This world loves sin. This world loves the demon-world. This world does not care about the work of Bible Deliverance.

What does the world care about healing of the sick or the casting out of demon spirits? We are in an unfriendly, cold, wicked world tonight! There are thousands of people who are losing their souls. They are turning from God and going to fortune-tellers, all of whom having real psychic powers are possessed with demon spirits. They have turned away from the knowledge of the Lord God. God can tell a man or woman more in five minutes than he or she would ever learn in a lifetime by dealing with demon-possessed people; but people love sin; they love darkness. There is a curse upon such people: the curse of God is upon every man and woman who turns to someone with a familiar spirit. Unless you repent and get right with God, you will go straight to hell!

These are the last days and anything you have been doing outside the will of God—stop it now! If you want the peace of God in this world and in the world to come, make a break with anything that would destroy your soul.

MEN SHOULD BE REVERENT

I have seen the demons twist people's bodies. One night I was praying for people in the healing line. Several were present to be delivered from demons. I always ask people to be reverent, to remain seated with heads bowed. A man over on my right would not bow his head; he was making fun and sitting there saying, "There's nothing to all this." I warned him, as I warn everybody when I come to cast out demons. I know that you might make fun of some things but don't ever make fun of the real power of God. You are digging your own grave when you do that; besides you are getting mighty close to blaspheming the Holy Spirit when you make fun of the works of the Holy Ghost. I warned him, I warned the crowd, urging everyone to be reverent. But the man sat

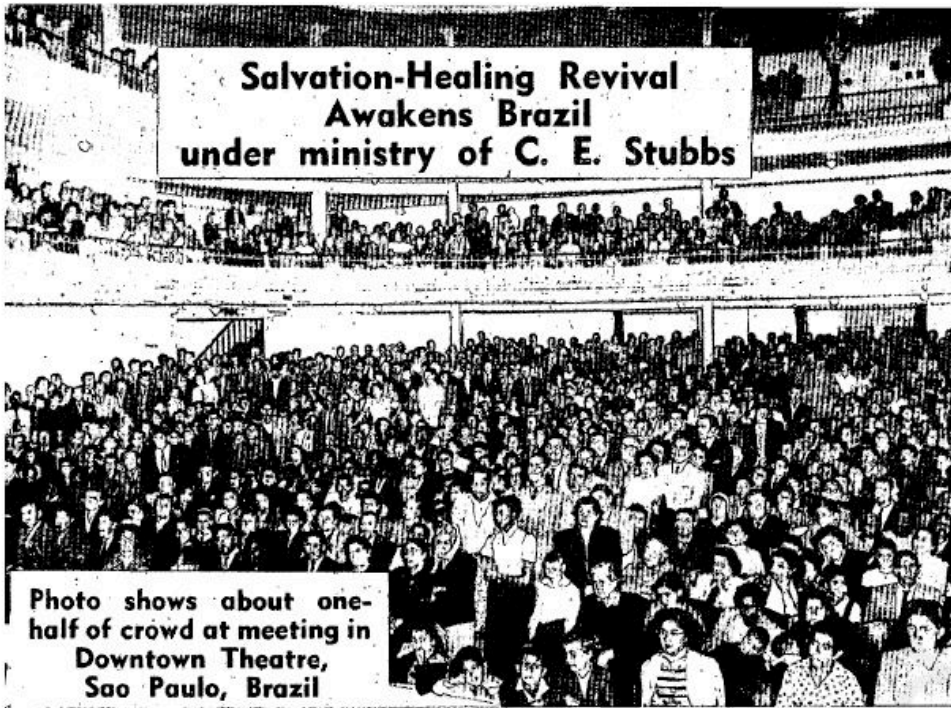


Photo shows about one-half of crowd at meeting in Downtown Theatre, Sao Paulo, Brazil

C. E. STUBBS IN BRAZIL

I shall never forget nor cease to praise the Lord for the blessings He sent to us in Brazil, through the ministry of our Brother C. E. Stubbs.

As we would hear of the wonderful revivals in America, and other lands, our hearts would ask, "Why is it that Brazil is not being blessed in the same manner?" Oh, yes, there have been many souls saved in Brazil, especially in the last 25 years, but no marked outpouring of God's blessing. One day without notice, Brother Stubbs called on the local native pastor. From then on, for nearly three months, the Lord used our brother with signs following. Doors were open everywhere. For the short period of his stay, many doors which were open could not be accepted, but many are praying that the Lord will make it possible that our brother, together with his wife and son, will return soon.

Having interpreted a good deal for our Brother Stubbs, I was in a position to see the hand of God move in our midst, night after

night, in the salvation of souls and the healing of many sick and afflicted. I was going to write that I would mention some of the outstanding cases which I saw with my own eyes, but when I come to think of it, there were so many outstanding cases that I hardly know which to write about, since it would be impossible for me to write concerning them all.

One case concerned a young lady who had been a deaf mute for many years—if not all her life. At first, she did not respond to prayer, and after the second or third time, she came forward for prayer, I must confess I had very little faith for her, but a month and a half later, she wrote her testimony. She could hear perfectly and was rapidly learning to talk. Through her testimony, she was the means of bringing many, with whom she had worked, to the Lord—since they had known her state before she was healed.

In a town called Santa Andre, a pastor was healed of three large ruptures. A doctor friend of his, knowing of his state before, and then seeing that God had healed him, came to the meeting. He went away a firm believer in the power of God to heal.

A lady in a town called Taubate, came to the meeting. She was supported on one side by

her daughter, a cane on the other. She was prayed for, and at first nothing seemed to happen. However, she wasn't discouraged, but kept on trying to walk, and one could see she was believing God too. Soon a light shown in her eyes. She walked faster and faster, then put down her cane and walked without any aid, except that which the Lord gave. The daughter stood gaping at her mother unable to really believe the truth, then finally they ran into each other's arms. They are now staunch members of the church.

Another lady who had tuberculosis, was prayed for. Several days later, she returned to the doctor, and was given a thorough examination. He gave her a card stating that there was now no trace of the tuberculosis.

Our brother often said the main object of the meetings was to win souls for Christ. In a congregation of over 2,000, I saw, in one night, at least 500 people raise their hands for salvation. They were asked to repeat the simple, yet sufficient, prayer of our brother. You may be sure they were saved immediately, if they earnestly repeated the prayer in faith believing. I am sure at least 10,000 people raised their hands for salvation in all these meetings. To God be all the glory.

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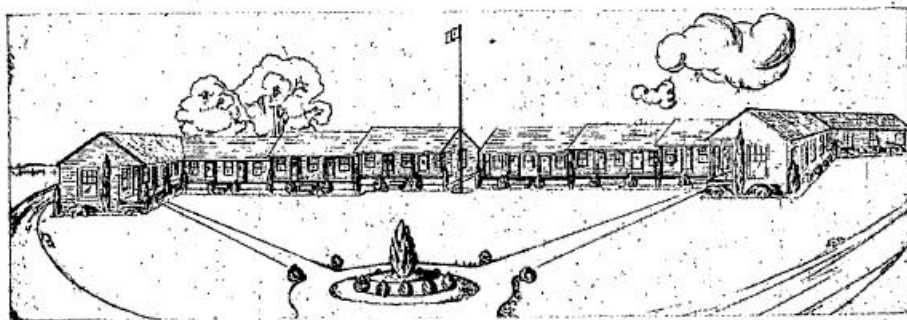


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ABOVE: Architect's drawing of Children's Home as it will appear upon completion. All but one unit of above is finished.

STORY OF THE JACK COE CHILDREN'S HOME

Toward the end of the revival meeting in Lubbock, Texas, a poor little ragged looking boy came up to me and said, "Please, preacher, give me a home." Those words seemed to stay with me, and then some woman who looked to be half Spanish and half American came up and jerked the little boy from me and said, "Come on, we're going home!" I inquired who the child was, and someone told me that his mother and father had gone off and left him, and this woman was taking care of him—no love, no words of kindness for this child.

I went home that night and tried to sleep, but those words kept ringing in my ears, "Please, preacher, give me a home." At the close of the meeting, the Lord gave me a \$500 love-offering. I went back to the City of Dallas, Texas, and picked out 10 acres of land, overlooking the city. I put a down-payment on it, and bought the ten acres for \$5,000. Just thirty minutes after I had bought it, some man came by and wanted to buy that same piece of land for \$10,000. The devil said, "There's your chance to make \$5,000." I answered, "I'm not interested in making \$5,000. God told me to make a home for children." So I began to build a home.

The above is the story from Jack Coe's lips of how the plan for the Herald of Healing Children's Home was born. Perhaps the fact that he, himself, spent eight years in an orphanage, where there he longed for Christian love, had a bearing on this remarkable step of faith. At any rate, just one year after God gave him this vision, a large part of the contemplated structure has been completed and furnished.

GREAT 3-DAY RALLY

On October 3-4-5, minister and other friends from far and wide gathered for a great Gospel rally under a tent, (kindly loaned by Mildred Wicks) pitched on the grounds of the Children's home. The power of God was

mightily present and it was obvious to all who attended that the blessing of God was richly upon the enterprise. Approximately five thousand dollars was given during the three days for the building of an additional unit. Applications for the admission of children to the home have already exceeded the number that can be taken care of, so the new unit is being added. Ministers joined in a groundbreaking ceremony for the beginning of its construction. Brother Coe mentioned that the Catholics had offered \$75,000 for grounds and buildings, but the offer was refused. Ministers who spoke expressed their belief that such an enterprise was sorely needed by the Full Gospel movement. In many cases, children who lost their parents have been taken by people or institutions who had no evangelical background. Added to the misfortune of losing their parents, the children suffered the fate of being reared under influences which often resulted in their living a life without Christ.

INSTANTLY HEALED OF RHEUMATIC FEVER



The day before Christmas, 1950, the doctor told me my son, Larry, had Rheumatic Fever. He took an x-ray of Larry's chest which showed the left side of his heart very much enlarged. An electrocardiogram was also made which revealed a very bad heart murmur.

Larry constantly ran a fever. The doctor said it might be a year or even two before the fever left. Even then he couldn't promise me that Larry wouldn't be an invalid for life.

Complete bed rest was necessary to prevent his heart from becoming even worse. He was also put on a very strict diet.

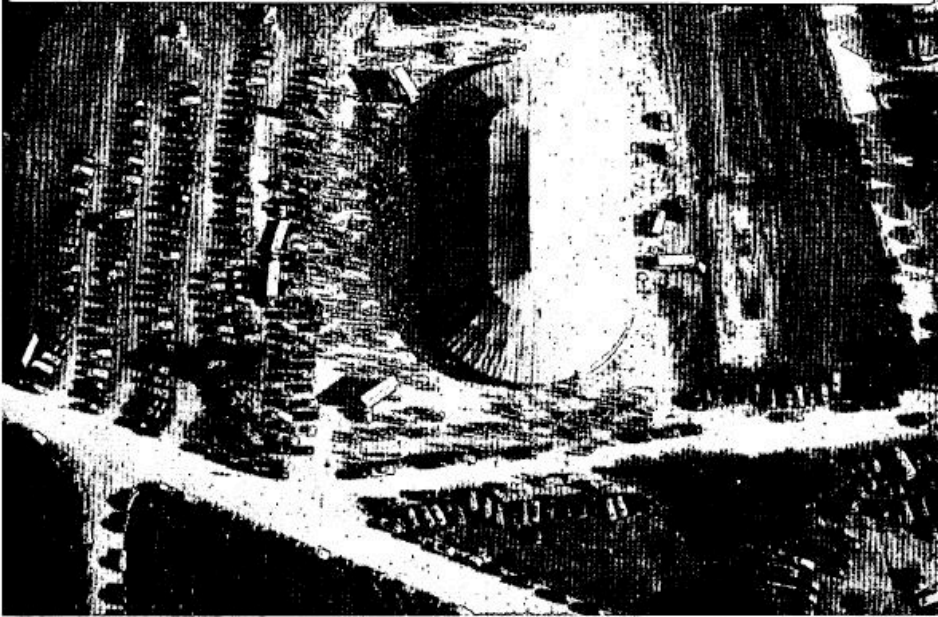

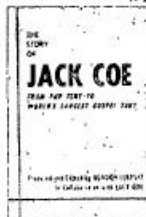

OUR EYES ON GERMANY



"Each morning a small group of us went to the Werner-Seelenbinder Hall, a great Communist meeting place, deep in the Soviet sector of Berlin, to attend the Bible Study led by Professor Dr. Rentdorf of Kiel. At 9:30 in the morning, eight to ten thousand people filled the hall,

while many more, unable to get in, listened to the loudspeakers outside. The earnestness and devotion of the congregation, many of them simple peasant people and youths, had to be experienced to be believed. And that hall was only one, and not the largest, of four."

That is the testimony of a British delegate to the recent Congress of the German Evangelical Church in Berlin. The solemn final ceremony in the Olympic stadium was attended by 100,000 people, who sang Luther's great hymn, "Ein feste Burg ist unser Gott." It must have been tremendous, as an affirmation of faith. "We beseech you to pray for us," said these German Christians from the East to the witness quoted above, "that we preserve our strength and our knowledge that we are one of an all-powerful, universal church."

Over against all that is the unpleasant fact that the Soviets have closed all the Pentecostal churches in the Eastern Zone; and my friends living there ask me not to send "Pentecost" directly to their homes because the authorities are suspicious of periodicals received from the West.

Tremendous spiritual forces are clashing in the very heart of Europe. No thinking person underestimates the menace of official and militant godlessness. But I am greatly heartened by the strength and fervor of the Evangelical Church in Germany. To me, personally, the best thing of all is that nearly 100,000 people will turn out for a Bible Study at 9:30 a. m.—therein is true strength. Other aspects of evangelical activity have their true place—a place given to them by Christ Himself. But always ultimately it is the Word that makes disciples. "Go ye . . . teaching" (Matt. 28:19-20) was the final command of our Lord.

Is strength to strength opposed now in Germany, not in weapons of carnal warfare, but in the things of the Spirit? My own recent visits have all impressed me deeply. It is easy now to preach the Word in Germany; it is easy to conduct successful evangelism, especially in contrast with England. One has a sense of a field "white unto harvest," and my friends all seem to feel the same. A letter from a young Indian friend who has just been preaching in Berlin, Bremen, Hamburg, Kiel, Neuminster, Frankfurt, and Stuttgart, reached me this morning. He says, "I found the German people thirsty for the Word of God—My stay in Germany has been a wonderful experience." Another friend writes of a repetition of Pentecost in Hamburg.

Keep your eyes on religion in Germany. Things are happening in the land of Luther, that may have much deeper import than the politicians envisage. What exciting days these are!

VISITATION OF SALVATION AND HEALING COMES TO HIROSHIMA THROUGH HARVEY McALISTER'S MINISTRY



HARVEY McALISTER CONDUCTS HEALING REVIVAL IN HIROSHIMA

By M. Mabel Francis

Aug. 6, 1945, 8:15 A. M.—At that moment of that fatal day, a huge bluish light flashed in the skies. Hiroshima, sixth largest city in Japan, with its 400,000 souls, was deprived of its heart and reduced to a barren desert. People in outlying districts just gazed at the mushroom-shaped cloud that shot up into the air several thousand feet, while tens of thousands in the city instantly died, cremated by devouring flames.

Hiroshima was again visited, June 28 to July 6, 1951—not by an atomic bomb explosion, nor destruction, nor death, nor sufferings, but by a mighty moving of God's Spirit, by forgiveness, by life, by healing. Victims of the bomb explosion, very many of them, were among the throngs ministered unto for healing during a nine-night healing mission, sponsored by Hiroshima's churches—Episcopal, Methodist, Lutheran, Baptist, Japan Alliance, Nazarene—with Harvey McAlister, of New York City, as guest speaker.

Miracles of Healing of Those Injured in Blast (Related by Akiel Ito, Japanese interpreter.)

"A cross-eyed man—a bomb explosion victim—who had lost his hearing, upon laying on of hands, received perfect hearing, and is now without his earphones.

"A woman suffering with tumor in the right eye, indirect result of explosion, who was being treated each day by the physician, examined by the physician the next day after being prayed for, was told that the tumor was gone. The explosion burns, raised up a full half-inch above normal level, softened almost immediately, and by morning skin had gone down to normal level.

"A woman whose house tumbled upon her in explosion suffered intense pains in her spine since August 6, 1945. When hands were placed on her back, all pains ceased immediately, and her face lit up as it were with a light.

"Returning to my home church, having witnessed such outstanding miracles, and my faith having been greatly built up thereby, I started in praying for the healing of the sick, and healing took place in each instance. Time is short, harvest is great, workers are few in number in Japan. Can not God send a heaven-born revival, with signs following, even to our beloved land of Japan?"

Effect of the Revival on Sergeant Jacob de Shazer

De Shazer was one of Doolittle's flyers. His plane was forced down in occupied China. He became a prisoner of war, spent 40 months

in prison, 30 of which were in solitary confinement. He was sentenced to death, but was later reprieved by Emperor Hirohito. He is now one of the best-known missionaries to Japan, and is much beloved by the Japanese people. (His story has been told in a recent issue of Reader's Digest.)

De Shazer ordered a projector for showing Gospel pictures to attract crowds, but upon witnessing the power of the Holy Ghost in operation in healing, and the mighty impact healing was making on the Japanese, the order was cancelled.

De Shazer says: "I shall never forget the joy that was mine when, under Brother McAlister's ministry, I realized healing belongs to Christ's Church. I immediately began to offer prayers for the healing of the sick. One day, the students of the Free Methodist Seminary and I prayed for a lame person who couldn't go upstairs without using crutches—but who, when prayed for, ran upstairs without crutches or even having to put hands on the stair rail—Hallelujah!"

Writes Sutoichi Cyo, Japanese pastor of Japan Alliance Church: "Having a Christian Missionary Alliance background, I naturally believed in Divine healing, but I confess that I was too fearful to put it into practice in a public manner, lest the sick should not be healed. These meetings have created within me a faith and courage I never before possessed. I am determined by God's grace to be true to my convictions regarding this precious practice of healing."

Totally Blind Girl Healed

(Related by Kanoa Oda, superintendent of Free Methodist Churches.) "Girl 22 years old, totally blind from childhood heard of Mr. McAlister's coming to our church, but thought 'there is no hope for a poor blind girl like me,' so she did not attend. Hearing of miracles of healing wrought in many persons whom she personally knew, she came to the camp with great expectancy and faith. She was prayed for on three different nights. The first night, she was able to see the faces of the people. The second night there was much clearer vision, and on the third night, she could read the print in the Bible. She came to camp with her white cane, led by others, but she left without guide or cane."

In conclusion, I must add a word about a vision the Lord gave me some years ago concerning the last days, the time just before our Lord's return. He revealed to me by means of this vision that there would be a great turning to the Lord, and that even as in the days when Christ was upon earth, very many would be healed. During those days when Mr. McAlister was with us in Maysuyama, I was reminded over and over again of that vision.

THE VOICE OF HEALING SALUTES "THE CHURCH OF GOD EVANGEL" FOR THE BEST ARTICLE OF THE MONTH ON UNITY OF THE BODY OF CHRIST

Condensed from July 21, 1951 issue, by Dr. J. H. Saayman, General Moderator of work in South Africa.

There never was a preacher who was more possessed with a sectarian spirit than I. I always believed that next to working for God, I was only to work in the interest and building up of the church organization to which I belonged.

During 1939, the Lord spoke to me to work for Pentecostal unity among the Pentecostal Churches of like precious faith. I was as sure as I was living that God had broken this sectarian spirit that I had, and had now given me love for all his people, no matter to what group they belonged. I started out with the message of Pentecostal organic unity. I do not claim that I followed the most desired way, but God knew my heart and my intentions. I do not profess to have the wisdom of Solomon. I was misunderstood by many, misinterpreted and misrepresented by scores who thought I was going to start a new church under the cloak of unity; but time convinced them of my sincerity.

CHRIST DIED THAT CHILDREN OF GOD SHOULD BE ONE

Yet, I knew that God had spoken to me; that it was His expressed desire for His Holy Ghost people to be together, for we read in John 11:51-52, "And this He spoke not of himself; but being high priest that year, he prophesied that Jesus should die for that nation; and not for that nation only, but that he should gather together in one the children of God that were scattered abroad."

It is clear from this passage of Scripture that Jesus died:

1. For the sins of the people
2. To gather together in one, the children that were scattered; i.e. UNITY.

If we claim that we are preaching the full gospel message, we have to preach:

1. Salvation through the blood of Christ
2. Unity among God's children.
3. Healing for the sick.

BELONGING TO THE INVISIBLE CHURCH

We have the visible and the invisible Church. To belong to the invisible Church means to belong to God's true worshippers, whose names may not appear on the records of the visible church, but whose names are written in the heavenly records, the Lamb's Book of Life. Heb. 12:22-23. It is to this Church that the apostle refers in Ephesians 5:27, "That he might present it to himself a glorious Church, not having spot or wrinkle, or any such thing, but that it should be holy and without blemish."

This invisible church is the one and only true Church constituted or made up of true Christians, being the body of Christ. This then, the bride of Christ, the household of God, the family of God, the building of God, the Church of the firstborn, is the only holy Church, and the only Church where you will find unanimity. This invisible Church is built upon the foundation of the apostles and the prophets of which Christ is the chief cornerstone.

Every minister of the Gospel should work for the perfection of the Church. We should not be competitors, striving to see who can get the greatest following, but we must be servants and workmen of God. God giveth the increase. For this is the Church that will endure unto the end, and against which the gates of hell shall not prevail. It is only members of this church who will hear from their Masters: "Well done; come and inherit the Kingdom." It is most essential that I make sure that I am a member of this Church.

Yet, we know that the Scripture very plainly refers to a visible church, the ecclesia, the called-out, to uphold the honour of God and to save the offender. What can we then expect of this visible church? In the first place, we cannot expect uniformity but unity. We cannot expect to have a church whose members are like a packet of matches. If you see one match, you know how the rest will look. Yet, we can expect a church which I will liken to a tree. The leaf differs from the twig, and the twig from the branch, and the branch from the trunk, yet it constitutes a complete unit—one perfect tree. We, therefore, cannot expect uniformity in the visible church but unity, for even in the early Church, they never had uniformity. They had some who advocated circumcision as in Jerusalem, yet the Pauline Church opposed circumcision. Paul says "Circumcision is nothing, and uncircumcision is nothing."

Romans 14:5, "One man esteemeth one day above another; another esteemeth every day alike."

In Ephesus, the church was ruled by bishops; in Rome, by elders; in Philippi, the women held prominent positions in the church; in Corinth, Paul did not allow women to ask anything in church.

In Matt. 18:17, we find the refractories had to be admonished by the disciples. In 1 Cor. 5:3-6, Paul expelled them from the church. In Matt. 13:30, we are taught that the wheat and the weeds had to grow together. In Matthew 25, you find the wise and the foolish virgins together. Among the first disciples you had an Ananias and a Sapphira. In the church at Philippi were enemies of the cross. Yet they did not split up into different factions. As Christ is one, so should His body (the Church) be one. We learn two lessons:

1. To watch against those who teach that we must have perfect uniformity.
2. To watch that we should never be discouraged, if we do not find a perfect church on earth.

It is, therefore, wrong of us not to fellowship with other Pentecostal movements. Yet, we know that it is God's will that, as there is an invisible Church, so there must also be a visible church.

The Lord knew that man will be apt to forget and that His truth must be handed down from generation to generation; therefore, He called the visible church. Just as nature provides a pod to protect the corn in the ear against the cold and frosts, in like manner the church, being the pod, must protect the truths against the onslaughts of the wind of hell through all the generations.

You can now see that God never intended us to labor separately from each other, or that everyone must go his own way, just with the Bible in his hand. He welded His children together, to be one body on earth, that this one and strong and fully equipped body could be able to spread His glorious truth from generation to generation, from land to land, from nation to nation. By being united, He sends us to the world to spread the gospel, to strengthen each other, to bear the burdens of each other.

When one is in severe pain, the greatest battle is to reject the false sense knowledge that denies the promise of God. If not properly taught, one is almost certain to accept the verdict of the pain, rather than to praise God for this sure promise of healing and deliverance.

A PREMATURE VICTORY

On Tuesday afternoon, I felt that victory had come. Simultaneously the great swelling opened and the poison began to drain out. Every hour or so, my wife would put a fresh hot pack on the place of infection, and the draining continued without cessation. The pain had ceased, and at last I could fully relax. God had graciously prevented the affliction from passing to any other part of my body—a remarkable exception to the normal and usual course of a carbuncle.

A DIABOLICAL TRICK OF THE ENEMY

I will admit that I was not prepared for the next development. Apparently Satan considered that there was much at stake in the outcome of the battle and had no intention of retiring from the field until he had played his last card. My father and mother were visiting us at the time. Father, who is seventy-eight years of age, had never been really sick once in his life. He has led a very temperate life, and has hardly known what sickness is.

At one o'clock on Wednesday morning, my wife was applying cloths, for the poison was flowing out very rapidly, and every couple of hours, she would apply the cloths. I had completely relaxed, and was enjoying the rest that was stealing over my body. At that moment, my father came into the room. I thought perhaps he had come to see how I was, but one look at him, and I knew something definitely was wrong. His face grimaced with pain. He informed us that his kidneys had locked, and I could see that he was in great agony. I also perceived that he was suffering so much that he would not be able to get victory himself. Satan, frustrated, had apparently lashed out against him.

I was distressed. There was my poor old father, whose hands had soothed my brow many a time. When, as a child, I was in need, he had waited on me more times than I can remember. Now there he was in pain and suffering, begging me to pray for him. It was almost more than I could bear. I arose from my bed, and with all my strength began rebuking the enemy. But soon my strength was exhausted, and I had to fall back on my bed. Five or six times, I arose to rebuke the enemy, but at last I fell back utterly exhausted. (Father recovered, for which we are thankful—Praise God!)

HAD I LOST MY HEALING?

As for me, I fell into a fitful sleep of exhaustion. I would see hallucinations and time after time I would wake with a sudden start. At length in the afternoon my wife came and looked at the carbuncle. It was red and angry, had increased in size, and worse—it had completely closed up. She had little to say. Her face was solemn, and the thought came to me, "Had I, through this over-exertion, lost my healing?" Temptations which are nothing at all in normal times, loom large when one's strength is completely exhausted. Yet, in my extremity, God helped me. I grimly determined to refuse to accept anything but that God had healed me. That was my decision, live or die—sink or swim.

Having no strength to pray, I picked up the Bible and read the story of Hezekiah's sickness unto death. He too had been afflicted with a terrible boil or carbuncle, and when he had inquired of the Lord, the prophet had brought him word, "Set thy house in order, for thou shalt die and not live." I read on. I

saw how Hezekiah had turned his face to the wall, and had plead with God to spare him and give him additional years of life. As a result of his prayers, God sent him a message that he should recover, and have fifteen additional years.

I read further. Though Hezekiah had been told of his healing, yet apparently the symptoms were still there—the hideous, terrible, death-dealing carbuncle was still on his body. The pain was there, and nothing apparently had changed. To stimulate his faith, he asked God for a sign. He was given his choice of whether the shadow would go forwards or backwards ten degrees on the sundial of Ahaz. Looking objectively at Hezekiah, we would probably think that the miracle of the shadow moving on the sundial would be far beyond the mere healing of a carbuncle. But as I lay there in bed, I could understand how that terrible, painful, nerve-wrecking boil, loomed larger to Hezekiah than anything else. He asked that the shadow go backward ten degrees, in order to give him faith for healing of his affliction, of which as yet he saw no signs of abatement.

Not in a moment, but gradually, I realized that God had given me a greater sign than He gave to Hezekiah—the sign of the Son of Man, "by Whose stripes we were healed." and "Who took our iniquities and bore our sicknesses." And when He did this on Calvary, the sun did not just retreat ten degrees, but it withdrew its shining altogether! When Jesus died, darkness came upon the face of the

entire land! Calvary is a sign to every sick person that Jesus has borne his sickness.

As I lay in bed, praising God for the healing, it seemed that a new strength came to me, and a voice seemed to say, "Do not doubt your healing." I fell asleep believing that victory had come, and Satan was defeated. When I awoke in the morning, I found that the swelling was going down rapidly, and the poison was again flowing from it. That was Thursday. By Monday, I was back at the office working, and that evening I attended a church service. Hallelujah! Praise the Lord! Hezekiah went up to the house of the Lord on the third day. I believe that I could have gone on the third day also, but friends told me I had better wait another day.

After Isaiah pronounced the healing, he also recommended that a special poultice should be placed on the boil. (11 Kings 20:7) The poultice had nothing to do with the miracle of healing, but its use demonstrates the fact that the Bible teaches that sympathetic care of the sick is in harmony with and not opposed to Divine healing. The external application of a fig poultice was applied to the swelling to draw the poison out. We didn't have any figs, but we obtained qualified advice as to what kind of poultice should be applied. (Isa. 38:21).

My testimony is that of Hezekiah after he had been healed. "The Lord was ready to save me, therefore we will sing my songs to the stringed instruments all the days of our life in the house of the Lord." Isa. 38:20.

SUDDEN DESTRUCTION

Global attention was focused on the Japanese peace-treaty conference when the representatives of 52 nations poured into San Francisco in September. The few days required for the treaty-signing conference seemed almost as if an era had been rolled into the storehouse of history.

The passing of time will reveal how the treaty will affect the Korean truce talks, and U. S. relations with Britain and France; what will be its effect on the future of Japan; and whether or not it will bring America closer to war with Russia.

Two other major conferences were held immediately after the San Francisco meeting. The Big Three met in Washington, followed by the twelve-power North Atlantic conference in Ottawa. All of these top-level talks are supposedly for the purpose of helping to guarantee peace in the world.

While diplomats talk and sign peace-treaties the wheels of industry continue to turn day and night in production of war equipment in feverish preparation for anticipated global-conflict. The student of Bible prophecy is significantly reminded that "when they shall say, Peace and safety; then sudden destruction cometh upon them"—1 Thess. 5:3.

DISTRESS AND PERPLEXITY

The Department of Commerce reported that Americans averaged an income of \$1,436 for each man, woman and child in 1950, a gain of \$116 or 9 percent over 1949. However, while per capita income increased more than 3 times in the past 12 years, the American living standard is 8 percent lower than in 1944. Inflationary high prices and high taxes have chiseled away at the living standard. The pre-war dollar of 1935-39 is only worth 54 cents today.

Retail food prices and rents led an upswing in the cost of living during June and July. Food and rent make up the major budget item for moderate income families in large cities.

The economic dilemma of this hour, and the apparent hopelessness of seeing a change for the better in the future, is causing great "distress" and "perplexity" (Luke 21:25), and is surely a definite sign of the end-time.

FAMINE

HONG KONG, Sept. 8. (UP) "A famine, officially described as 'disastrous,' is sweeping North China . . . The official New China News Agency said the famine has affected at least 3,000,000 persons in Pingyuan and Chahar provinces . . . The famine was attributed to drought, floods and insect pests which ravaged crops." Famines of increasing intensity are clearly foretold by Jesus (Luke 21:11) as definite signs of His second coming.

LOVERS OF PLEASURE

While millions in China are starving to death a Mexican millionaire tossed a fabulous \$200,000 all-night bizarre party for 660 guests in Venice, Italy, recently. One guest wore a gown of lace and sequins reportedly costing \$15,000. The 'palace warming' social gathering followed the expenditure of an estimated \$6,000,000 for refurbishing the palace on the Grand Canal.

Cultivation of flowers in Israel is carried on all the year round and is expanding so rapidly and the quality of flowers improving so much that they are expected to be in good demand in countries such as the United States, Switzerland, Belgium, and Sweden. An American florist who visited Israel recently is reported to have already ordered about \$50,000 worth of Israel flowers.

It appears we are nearing the time of Kingdom blessing for Israel when "the wilderness . . . and the desert shall rejoice, and blossom as the rose"—Isa. 35:1.

FANTASTIC WEAPONS

there and looked at me. I said, "All right, you'll take your responsibility, I won't. If you'll do as I say, I'll take responsibility for you and nothing will happen to you." He took his own responsibility. Through the power of God, I cast the demons out of the man I was praying for. The dispossessed demons went through the audience seeking someone to enter. They struck this irreverent man a body blow and knocked him completely out of his chair onto the ground. The ushers found him writhing and twisting and biting his tongue and trying to scream out his misery. I told the ushers to bring him to me. They picked him up and carried him to me on the platform. It took me five minutes to get him delivered by the power of God. When he walked off that platform he was a different man. He will never make fun again. That has happened several times in our meetings and people have learned to fear God and know that God is alive in these last days. Now is the time to worship and reverence God, not to make fun of His holy power of deliverance.

I have seen demons control people, twisting and convulsing their bodies and tormenting their minds, making them scream out day and night. Oh, I hate the ugly power of the devil and his demon-world. God has put a love in my heart for demon-possessed people and I tell you now if you attend our meetings night after night you will see this power against demons.

There are many kinds of demons. The most powerful of all are the "unclean" demons. No unclean demon can enter a child of God, because it cannot cross the bloodline of Christ. Neighbor, I am glad I am saved tonight! I am glad I am sanctified and filled with the Holy Spirit. When you are baptized with the Holy Ghost and fire there will be no danger of unclean spirits crossing the bloodline and possessing your life. I know that this wicked world sneers at the Holy Ghost and the Full Gospel people and I know the modern church tries to look down on us, but we are the safest people in the world. We are the safest people because we have the Holy Spirit of God in us.

Now, demons work in three different ways. They work either in the soul or the mind or the body. At rare times, they work in all—simultaneously. That is, a person can have unclean demons and be bound in soul, mind and body at the same time. On the other hand, there are various kinds of demons that work in the body of a person, even in the body of a Christian. For instance, Jesus dealt with deaf and dumb spirits. He called them that. So we know deaf and dumb demons do take the hearing and speech of some people. Not all deafness is caused by deaf and dumb spirits; it might be caused by heredity; it might be caused by pneumonia or by a fall or something like that, but there is a certain form of deafness that will never respond to a hearing aid or anything else except the healing power of Christ calling out the deaf spirit. Then they can hear.

The invisible demon-realm is located in the air, is located between us and God. To reach God, our faith must push its way through enemy territory. This is why our prayers are often beaten back in our faces. That is why sometimes our sermons are beaten back in our faces. That is why that sometimes the atmosphere is cold and chilled and we feel satanic pressure against us, for when we pray to God these demons are there to oppose us and to push our prayers back at us but God says, "Resist the devil and he shall flee from you." I believe that because I have practiced it and know it can be done. It is being done by people all over the world in Jesus' name.

There is only one place where an unclean demon cannot go and that is in the heart of a child of God. All other people are open to demon-power. I mean by that, they have no defense against unclean spirits. The only one defense is the name of Jesus Christ, the Son of God!

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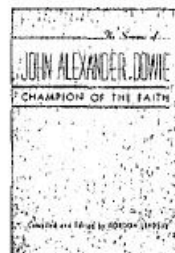
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
