

SALVATION

When I got down the street, I saw my wife's car. I went and knocked on the door of the house where her car was parked.

This girl answered the door and said, "Come in Raf. We've been expecting you."

Now I didn't even know I was going there. When someone says that – it makes you stop and wonder how she knew.

I said, "How were you expecting me?"

I looked at Denise and she said, "Yes, she told me at 7 o'clock this evening that you were coming." I was there at 10.30 at night. Three and a half hours before I arrived, this girl had spoken to Denise and said, "He's coming here tonight. He's going to be giving his heart to the Lord."

And I said, "Is this girl touched? Is she a nutcase or what?"

Denise said, "No, no. She told me that you were coming here tonight."

I said, "How did you know that?"

The girl said, "God speaks to me." Then I really thought she was nuts.

I said, "God speaks to you? Are you for real or what?"

She said, "Yes. He told me a bit more Raf. He told me more about your life."

I said, "What did He tell you?"

She said, "Ten years ago you were in a bad spot and you actually turned to Him and told Him that you would give Him your life if He could get you out of this tight spot."

She said, "He's calling on that today." Nobody knew about that except the Lord and me.

Nobody. So I understood that this girl could tap into God. I wanted that the minute I heard that. I wanted it. I thought, "Hang on, I'm sick of this old stuff. I want the new." And I gave my heart to the Lord.

I woke up a different man the very next day. But I understood one thing; that a walk with God had to be a walk where we could hear, walk and talk with Him. It's not enough to have a religious experience and not continue. It's not enough to think we have Jesus. I hear so many people say, "It's all in His Word, His Word, His Word." And it is.

It is His Word but if you haven't got an experience, you'll be the same as the

Pharisees who thought that by looking in the Word they had salvation and they missed the One who was bringing it. We need relationship. We need to know Him. We need to have time with Him.

He started training me. He started training me in hearing His voice. On the building sites I used to do some hands-on stuff. I used to dig the footings and do all manner of things because I liked being out amongst the guys.

After a few years of bringing people to the Lord on the sites, I was digging a trench one day when I heard Him speak to me in an audible voice on a building site.

Have you ever heard Jesus speak in an audible voice? It's terrible when He does that: it's because we're pretty deaf and can't hear the quiet voice!

I was like that and He had to speak to me pretty harshly because I couldn't hear His voice normally. But He said, "Get ready. Get ready." He said, "I'm sending you overseas."

Now I didn't know what 'get ready' was. I thought I was ready. I actually thought I was ready because I had led people to the Lord. I thought I was ready because I could share the gospel.

I thought I was ready because I could lay hands on the sick and they would recover. I thought I was ready. But then I realised that I didn't really know Him.

I'd done all the things that I could learn and see and touch that the Church could teach and the Bible College could teach us. I thought I was ready and then I thought I didn't really know Him. I didn't know the Lord the way I was supposed to.

When He said, "Get ready," I said, "Lord, aren't I ready?"

And He said this to me... absolutely nothing, not a thing. Silence. All day I was wondering about this word He'd spoken audibly.

"Get ready, get ready, get ready. I'm sending you overseas. Get ready!"

I said, "How do I get ready?" I could not get this out of my mind all day long. I was trying to work.

I had to drop work because I couldn't concentrate on work. I went and got my Bible and started opening it up thinking maybe the answer was going to be in there for me. Get ready.

That night at 1.30 in the morning, the Lord knocked on the door of my heart. The Spirit of God spoke to me. He said, "Raf. Purpose your heart. Purpose

your heart to spend some time with Me.”

We need to purpose our heart to spend time with Him. This word was burnt deep into my spirit, deep into my heart because He woke me up with it.

He said, “Purpose your heart. Purpose your heart Raf. Purpose your heart to spend time with Me.”

I said, “What do you want Lord?”

He said, “Get out of bed and come and spend some time with Me.”

Get out of bed? Do you know how cold it is in Adelaide in the middle of winter? Do you know that there's a blanket that can get hold of you and will not let you out of the bed? As much as you are struggling, wanting to get out.

Do you know that there will be a struggle on the inside when God wants something from you? I couldn't get out of bed.

I said, “Can't we talk here Lord? It's warm! You know I didn't think there was any problem with distance, space or time with You. You are the Master of all those things.”

He said, “It's not Me that's the problem. You are Raf. Get out of bed! Come and have some time with me. Purpose your heart.”

Well, those words just hit me like someone striking a bell. So, I got out of bed at 1.30 in the morning and I went down the back of the house into the family room. I sat down there and said, “OK, what are we going to speak about Lord?”

Guess what He said? Nothing. Absolutely nothing. He said nothing at all. He got me out of bed and then said nothing. Can you believe that God would do that?

I went to work the next day and actually I was angry. I was kicking the floor. Three and a half hours I was awake that night, wondering what to do with my time. I opened up the Psalms and read them to Him. I thought that would work! I was just doing some of the things that some Christians do - trying to get in to the presence of God.

I thought, “Lord, You woke me up but You wouldn't talk to me?”

I was cheesed off. All day I was thinking about this. I went to sleep the next night.

Two o'clock in the morning – I was awake. He gave me a half hour's grace!

And He said this, “Purpose your heart Raf. Purpose your heart.”

I said, "Lord, You wouldn't talk to me last night after You got me out of bed. Are You going to talk to me tonight?"

And He just kept repeating these words, "Purpose your heart".

I couldn't stand it any longer. I got out of bed, went down to the back room, sat down and said, "Well I know You are there Lord and You know I am here! So, what are we talking about?"

Absolutely nothing!

He did this for eight nights running.

He'd wake me up. You can't resist the voice of God when He wakes you up, when He speaks to you. We can't resist the voice of the Lord when He speaks to us.

He woke me up, put me in that room again and on the ninth night He spoke to me. Boy, do I wish that He hadn't at that time. I had to struggle with things that I couldn't give over.

You might be doing something very similar to what I was doing in that room, searching your heart before God. When God wants to touch some stuff that's going on in your life, He doesn't take no for an answer.

I can remember leaving that room bawling my eyes out. Crying my eyes out. Because I couldn't give over the things that He was asking for.

I couldn't give it over. And I started crying.

I left the room. I went back to bed and I just couldn't sleep after that. I was just undone.

The next night I got up and said, "Lord, what are we going to speak about today?"

And He said, "Let's get back to yesterday's topic."

Have you ever been in that place where He won't let you get past the thing He wants.

Things that He wants because He wants to make us perfect. He wants to manifest Himself in us.

People say, "Oh we'll never be perfect." But we can be perfect in Christ.

It's just a transition. It's a journey. It's a giving over. We can be perfect in the Lord. Because He *is* perfect. Give Him full reign in our life and we'll end up perfect.

We'll have no excuse.

God has planted a seed in us. There's a seed that's on the inside of us. That seed has a blueprint.

That seed is the incorruptible seed of Jesus.

When He came into our life that seed was planted in us. It was tiny, the tiniest seed but in it there was a blueprint for our life.

Everything we are going to be doing in our life is in that seed. It starts here in our life on earth and finishes when we meet Jesus in Heaven at the end of our earthly life.

In that seed, is everything we are going to do, every person that we are going to lay hands on, every person we are going to have conflict with.

Every healing, every miracle, every deliverance is in that seed. Every miracle of supply that we need.

Some of us struggle. God says that He doesn't take no for an answer.

He said, "Look into that seed Raf. It's already in there. Everything you need is already built in. When I brought you into the Kingdom, I brought you everything that you needed with it. But it's a mystery until I reveal it to you. It's a mystery that's on the inside and if you will allow my Holy Spirit to take hold, He will reveal the mystery of your life to you, and set you on a path that will shock you. It will be the greatest adventure that you have ever had in your life."

Every day is an adventure for me. Every day.

He trained me in that closet of prayer, of spending time with Him to hear and to do. If I don't hear I don't do. I'd rather do nothing than do something in my own strength and see no fruit for it. We need to have testimonies in our quiver.

Do you know the easiest way to share Jesus Christ in a nutshell? It's to tell people about something He did in your life or for somebody else. Have a quiver full of testimonies. Some people find it hard to go and share Jesus but I don't find it hard at all. I just share with them and tell them about the woman who came out of the stroke.

I tell them about the bloke on the aeroplane queue.

We were stuck in Adelaide airport. Fog had closed off South Australia, including flights to Sydney. It threw every flight into chaos so we had a six hour wait for an aircraft.

We thought, "Ah this is good. We'll have some time with our wives. We'll have a bite to eat at the airport. Just relax, have a holiday. Have a day off!"

But all of a sudden, people started popping up all over the airport. The place was full of people. We could have had a meeting there.

So, we started talking to a couple of people from the south east of South Australia that we ran into, and then another couple of ladies came over from the other side and started talking to us. Then we were in the line getting vouchers for food while we were waiting for the plane to take off.

So, I said to Jim, "After we get the vouchers for the food, we'll pray for the fog to lift."

There was a guy behind me in the line and he was a farmer. I turned around to him and said, "Don't worry mate. As soon as you get your vouchers the fog will be lifting and we'll be going early. Don't listen to the aircraft times."

We were supposed to leave at 12noon and now they had scheduled us for 7pm.

I said, "We just prayed. The fog's about to lift. But we want the voucher in our hands first."

The guy burst out laughing and said, "You obviously aren't praying hard enough."

I looked at him and looked into his eyes and I could see that he was full of the Holy Spirit. I asked him if he was a Christian and he said he was. I asked him why he was going to Sydney and he said, "I'm going because Benny Hinn's there and I have a bad heart."

I said, "It looks like you're going to miss the meeting. You're in luck, you know. We'll be able to pray for you today in the line to get healed."

He said, "Would you?" We ended up praying for this man and God healed him. He was also deaf so we took the hearing aids out (we thought we'd do a thorough job), stuck our fingers in his ears and he got instant hearing.

I said to him, "Now you know that He can heal your heart."

We laid hands on his heart and I said, "You're going to breathe easier and that will be the sign to you that your heart's fixed."

We've never seen a man so full of joy. His wife was almost doing cartwheels. She wouldn't leave us alone all the way to Sydney.

We need to take opportunities and reveal Jesus wherever we go. We need to take opportunities to reveal the power of God.

So often we like to speak about Him but then leave the people with nothing. I think people get ripped off when that happens because the One who lives in us is the One who can do the impossible.

We limit Him because of our thinking. The Kingdom of Heaven has to be on us. We have to change the atmosphere wherever we go. We have to change the spiritual atmosphere in every place we go to. This is how we minister the gospel.

My wife and I went to Israel on holiday. My wife had been wanting to go to Israel for so long but I kept putting it off. We ended up going all over the world but not to Israel. We had three weeks without an appointment.

I thought, "Great. We're going to get away." So, I booked the tickets.

She came home on a Monday and I said, "Pack your bags. We're off to Israel. We're going to have a holiday. We have three weeks off."

She said, "Are you sure that this will be a holiday?"

I said, "Yes. Guaranteed. I'll leave my Bible and computer home."

I actually lost my phone at the airport on the way so I thought, "Well, God wants me to have a holiday."

My wife was so happy. We ended up in Israel. I wanted to have a look at Israel and see the truth of what was happening in the place.

I wanted to see what was happening with the Israelis and the Palestinians. We ended up staying in every area of Israel.

We stayed with some Palestinians. We ended up in some places that you wouldn't usually go to.

We saw some things that were horrific. We stayed with some Jews. We ended up in a settlement with some beautiful people.

We ended up in a kibbutz run by a Hasidic rabbi. This man's father was dying in hospital. His father had had kidney disease for six years and they had just taken him to hospital and they didn't expect him to come home.

The rabbi was basically living in the hospital looking after his father. I said, "Would you mind if I prayed for your Dad?"

Denise looked at me – I was supposed to be on holidays. I said, "I reckon I can guarantee that he'll get healed and come out (of hospital)."

He said, "You can guarantee that?"

I said, "Yes." Are we willing to guarantee these things? Who are we serving –

He can do it but we are the brake. We stop everything.

I said, "I guarantee that your Dad will come out of hospital."

He said, "How can you guarantee that?"

I said, "Because I heard. I heard what his problem is. I heard what the root is and I heard how to cut it off."

Hearing what someone's problem is, asking the Lord for the root cause and cutting it off at the root and seeing them set free is the key to evangelism.

Jesus came to destroy the works of the devil. We are the instrument He can use.

A lot of Christians think that we have to be meek and mild doormats but we don't have to be that at all. Jesus was a strong, powerful man. He had to be – I saw the wilderness in Israel. Anybody who was going to walk for forty days in that wilderness was no meek, mild, weak person.

Jesus also left His deity up in Heaven when He came to Earth.

Why did He choose to come as a man?

He came as a man to reveal the way to us, the way that we should be walking.

Jesus said He could do nothing of Himself. He couldn't heal or deliver. He couldn't set anybody free. It was the Father in Him who did the work.

Who is it who lives in us? Jesus.

He is now doing the work in us. And He said, "It's finished." If it's finished that means that it's a foregone conclusion that wherever we go we should see the fruit of the gospel.

John 5:19 "Then Jesus answered and said to them, "Most assuredly, I say to you, the Son can do nothing of Himself, but what He sees the Father do; for whatever He does, the Son also does in like manner."

When I was in Israel the Lord showed me why this man was in hospital.

He gave me the key. He was a Holocaust victim and he hadn't forgiven.

I said to the man, "If you can't forgive, God can't forgive you. You're going to hell."

His eyes were like saucers. I said, "Do you realise that you must forgive so that God can forgive you?"

The vessel that we use to forgive is what God will take hold of and pour out over us. So, use a big vessel for forgiveness so God can pour forgiveness out

on us.

He takes hold of the same thing that we use and pours it out upon us. When I told the old man this I said, "There's a key to your sickness."

I told him the story about my Dad and I told him that it was the same story for him – forgive.

The man forgave immediately and I told him that in two days he would be out of the hospital and I left.

Within two days he was out of hospital. Healed.

There are root causes for sickness. Sin and sickness are synonymous. Generally, sickness is the child of sin. It's the fruit of sin.

In Romans chapter 6 it says that we are not to let sin reign in our mortal bodies.

So why would we let sickness reign in our mortal bodies above Jesus Christ who lives in us?

Why would we let sickness reign in us above the Lord and Master who's taken hold of us?

This challenges me to the very core.

Whenever I get a twinge of anything I'm full on against it straight away. I don't want to get comfortable with it. I don't want to let it get hold.

The greatest drawback when we go into a hospital to pray for someone who's sick is generally the relatives. The relatives will stop us. Their attitude is he's sick, so how can we go in there and have joy in our hearts. Joy is the very thing he needs. I ask all the relatives to leave while I pray for the person.

Sometimes I take my computer in with me and show some 'before' and 'after' shots of people who've been prayed for by T.B. Joshua. Then I ask if he wants that (healing) because if Jesus can do it for them, He can do it for you. Simple gospel – Jesus comes.

I've seen people with tumours so big that they can't sit up in bed and the minute I share that Jesus can do it, if they can receive it, the tumour shrinks.

But we have to get rid of all the negativity.

We have to get rid of the people who will stop it because they're feeling sorry for the sick person. Feeling sorry for him all the way to his grave.

Wouldn't we rather bring life? What did Jesus do? In the Bible, I never once saw Him send someone to their grave.

I've heard people pray like this, "Oh I think their time's up. I think it's time for them to go." They can't be serving the same God I am.

He says He's looking for overcomers. In New Guinea when they go into the hospital to pray for the sick, they won't leave until the sick person comes out with them.

He's given it to us. We have the greatest evangelism tool when we start to release healing to people. We need to allow Jesus to do what He does most normally, the thing He does, the thing that heaven comes down here on earth, the normal thing that we should be seeing.

Testimonies of healings.

This rabbi coming out of hospital set the place alight. Then these people asked me to pray for the sick people they knew who were Russian Jews.

They were the poorest of the poor in Jerusalem. I said I would pray for them so they set up a meeting.

I ended up in a house meeting. We were all sitting around in a house. There was a lovely girl who could speak English, Hebrew and Russian.

I spoke in English and she translated into Hebrew and then Russian so that everybody could understand. I thought that this would be long-winded so I kept it simple.

I asked if they all knew Jesus. Some didn't.

I asked if they had all come out of Russia because they believed in God.

I said, "His Son was given to pay the price for your sins so all we have to do is say thank you. Can you say thanks?"

Simple gospel. They all started saying thank you. The power of God came into the room.

There was a woman there who had had a stroke so I said, "Let's start with you. You look like a simple case."

I started to lift her hand up and a woman in the background said, "Stop him. He's hurting her."

Remember, it's always those closest who will stop us because they're feeling sorry for someone.

I turned around to her and said, "Shut up. I know what I'm doing."

That sounds rude but sometimes we have to be rude to shut people down so that they don't rob us of the spiritual things.

My wife was on the edge of her seat. She said, "Raf, if she had got up, I would have knuckled her."

My wife is the quietest person you have ever met but she knew that this woman was getting set free.

The next thing was that the woman had joy in her heart – she lifted her arm and walked out of the stroke.

Jesus had turned up. We allowed Him out. We broke this outer shell so that He could get out of us. Where does He live? In us.

We think that it's us doing it but it isn't. It's Him doing it through us.

We have to get rid of the idea that it's us doing it. We can do nothing without Jesus.

He could do nothing without the Father. It's the same pattern, the same principle.

He's taking us into places and remember, it's already in the seed that's planted in us. Every exploit that has been set for us to do is already in that seed that's been planted in us.

How many have we missed? It's not too late.

I get our people praying, "Lord, give us divine appointments."

We started our church with nothing. We started teaching people to get in the prayer closet and hear God's voice.

Spend time with Him so that we can sharpen up our hearing. When it comes to hearing about specific things, we all have problems but we need to spend time with Him to sharpen our hearing.

"Help!" is a good prayer but we need to spend time to hear clearly. To sharpen our hearing, we do things like working in pairs, one will go somewhere within thirty kilometres and the other one will ask the Holy Spirit where they are and go to them.

The Holy Spirit knows where we are. We just have to hear.

My 2IC (second in charge) didn't believe that we could hear God clearly. He said, "Raf, I'll go and hide tomorrow. You find me."

I said, "Okay. Make it between the hours of nine and ten in the morning. That will give me enough time to get there. You hide anywhere you like on the South Coast, from the mouth of the River Murray to Waitpinga – thirty kilometres, and ten kilometres inland. You can hide anywhere."

I got up at 4 o'clock in the morning and said, "Lord, I don't want to be a smartie pants but would You please tell me where he's going to be. I want to be waiting for him. You show me where he's going to be."

Instantly the Spirit of God spoke to me and said, "Rosetta." I started wracking my brain.

"Rosetta." I thought, I know what Rosetta means.

There was a rural agency selling farm things that was called Rosetta Rural Agency. All of a sudden logic kicked in.

Rosetta Rural Agency was owned by this man's cousin and he would often go there and have a coffee with him in the mornings.

So, I thought that that was where he was going to be. I was going to be sitting there waiting for him later in the morning. I was going to get there at one minute to nine. I was so happy that the Holy Spirit had told me "Rosetta."

I went back to bed. I got up later and as I was driving down, He said, "Raf, why did you stop listening to me?"

I said, "Lord, You talked to me. You said Rosetta."

He said, "But then you went to bed. You didn't let Me finish." Then He gave me a geography lesson.

The Holy Spirit can be very exact. He said, "Rosetta Head."

That's the name of the big bluff on our coast. Everyone calls that place The Bluff. I've never heard it called anything but The Bluff.

He said, "Keep listening. Don't stop listening."

When He teaches us stuff it's very simple – purpose our heart, keep listening. He does it.

So, I kept listening. I said, "Lord, are You serious?" I pulled over and got out my street directory and on the map of the Coast was Rosetta Head, the correct geographical name for the place and in brackets underneath was 'The Bluff.'

I thought, "That's the other side of where I'm going. It's going to take me another fifteen minutes to get there. I'm going to be late now."

All He kept saying to me was, "Keep listening."

We have to keep listening because circumstances change.

We get set on a track, on a teaching about discipleship and evangelism but

God says to stay open so that He can reach us because there is stuff that we don't know, stuff that our lecturers don't know but He wants to touch us with His stuff.

His ways are different to ours. We have to stay open. Denominational thinking can stop us receiving what God has for us today. There are no denominations in heaven.

God wants to make us effective in releasing the gospel. The end purpose is to find out what Gods' will is so that we can release people into it.

Saved, unsaved – it doesn't matter. Everybody needs to come to that place.

By this time, I was wondering how I could keep listening so I put some music on and I tried to stay in the Spirit by concentrating on God. I was keeping my ear on the Lord and if He wanted to talk to me, I was listening. I was open. I was listening with my spiritual ears, keeping open to the Lord.

I got to the corner where the Rosetta Rural Agency was, the first place I was going to go.

He said, "Turn right, Raf. He's changed his mind." God is a chatterbox. Our hearing is a bit dull. When He starts talking, He talks. He is very articulate. He will share things with us that will scare the living daylights out of us because we'll have to do them.

The Lord said, "He's changed his mind. It's too hot. He's decided to work at home. He's closed off all his house, locked his car in the garage and he's pretending he's not home."

I turned right. I checked my watch and it was one minute to nine. I knocked on the door and there was no answer.

I said, "Come on. Open the door. I know you're in there."

No answer. I said, "Come on. Open the door. I know you're in there." Still no answer.

I said, "Do you want me to break the door down because I'm coming in?"

He opened the door and asked, "How did you know I was in here?"

I said, "I could have told you where you were going to be."

He said, "Oh you smartie pants. Where was I going to be?"

I said, "You were going to go to The Bluff."

He started crying and said, "Yes."

I said, "But you changed your mind because it's too hot."

He said, "Yes."

I said, "You know, God can reveal the very hearts of men. If we ask."

We don't have because we don't ask. That's the only reason we don't have it. We've never asked. We've never become creative in God to want to do things differently.

We're happy to get taught Bible, things that people can come and easily rattle off but God is creative. God is open. He wants us to be open.

We may be the very vessel that He's put in the stop gap for someone who's going to hell and if we close our hearing off, we'll miss it and someone will go to hell.

This is important. Training should be fun – God loves having fun. I hate seeing people trying to show Jesus Christ but having the sourest look and their lives just don't show that He's there. When He comes, joy comes.

A word for someone: Cast all your cares upon Jesus for He cares for you. The enemy goes around like a roaring lion seeking whom he may devour. But don't think it's such a strange thing – all the problems that you're going through and the insurmountable mountains in front of you -because your brothers and sisters all over the world are going through similar things. But submit to God. Submit to God. Resist the devil. Resist the devil.

What qualifies us for the devil to devour us? The care that we take on – it's a major qualification for the enemy to rob us.

Do not take on care, roll it over to the Lord. Roll our care over to Jesus. We've heard people say to be care-full, we need to be care-empty.

The thing that closes us off most to hearing the Word of God is letting the cares that will choke us take hold. Then we'll end up with a sour look. Release them.

Taking on care is like waving a flag in the spirit realm for the enemy to come and get us.

God says that He's broken it at the cross. He took it from us, so why keep it. We don't need to hold on to it. He says, "Don't qualify yourself for the enemy to get hold of you." Give it to Him. He can do it. Trust Him with it.

Final-Word
